The total number of visitors to Manchester BID for the last 52 weeks is 37,663,540 which is 14.4% up on the previous year.


The total number of visitors for the year to date is 25,456,255 which is 13.8% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors to Manchester BID in week commencing 17 September 2023 was 675,552.


The busiest day in week commencing 17 September 2023 was Saturday with 136,738 visitors.

The peak hour of the week was 15:00 on Saturday 23 September 2023 with footfall of 16,033.


Footfall Counts by week











Footfall Counts by hour




Footfall Counts by week

2019 comparison for Manchester BID


