The total number of visitors to Manchester BID for the last 52 weeks is 35,116,521 which is 20.5% up on the previous year.


The total number of visitors for the year to date is 2,268,813 which is 31.4% up on the previous year.


The total number of visitors to Manchester BID in week commencing 22 January 2023 was 611,782.

The peak hour of the week was 13:00 on Saturday 28 January 2023 with footfall of 15,207.


Footfall by week Weather









Footfall by day




Footfall by hour



2019 comparison for Manchester BID


