


For the second week in a row footfall declined significantly from last year, with an annual drop of -8.7% across all UK retail destinations, although the bad news is mitigated by the fact that there was a +2.1% uplift from the week before. Indeed, the divergence between the annual result and the weekly one is likely to be a function of the fact that Week 14 last year was Easter week, and so benefited from activity driven by Good Friday and Easter Saturday.





Weekly Percentage Changes (rolling 13 weeks)









Counting By Location Main Locations Only








Weekly Retailer Sales Index
