The change in footfall for Manchester BID over the last 52 weeks is 6.9% down on the previous year.


Footfall for the year to date is 14.4% down on the previous year.

The number of visitors counted for week commencing 22 March 2020 was 119,974.


The busiest day in week commencing 22 March 2020 was Monday with 30,154 visitors.

The peak hour of the week was 12:00 on Monday 23 March 2020 with footfall of 3,194


Footfall by week Weather








Footfall by hour




Footfall by week
