

The change in footfall for Manchester BID over the last 52 weeks is 5.7% up on the previous year.


Footfall for the year to date is 4.5% up on the previous year.

The number of visitors counted for week commencing 29 April 2018 was 733,133.


The busiest day in week commencing 29 April 2018 was Saturday with 139,276 visitors.


