The total number of visitors to Manchester BID for the last 52 weeks is 32,570,639 which is 54.5% up on the previous year.

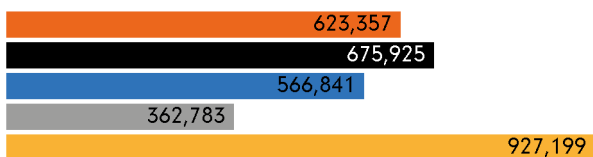
The total number of visitors for the year to date is 14,361,327 which is 47.7% up on the previous year.

The busiest day in week commencing 19 June 2022 was Saturday with 112,944 visitors.

The peak hour of the week was 15:00 on Saturday 25 June 2022 with footfall of 14,498.

Footfall by week

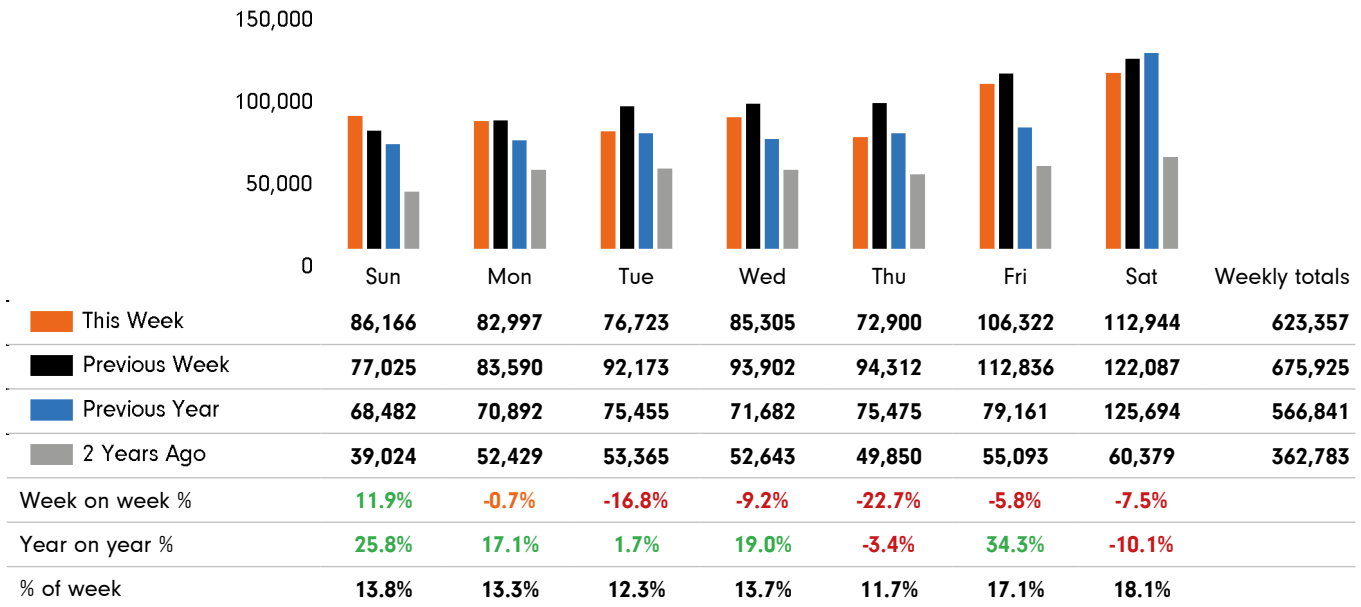

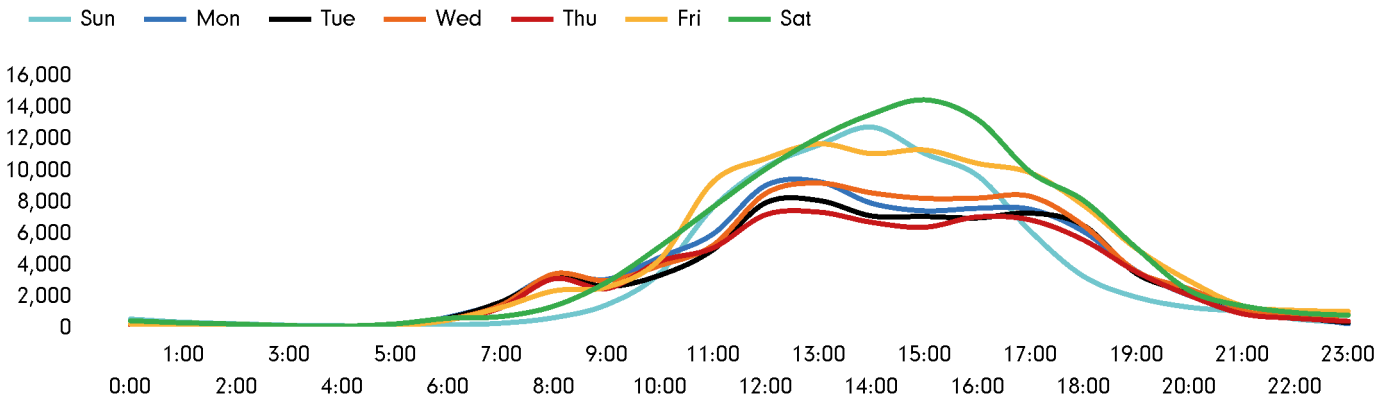

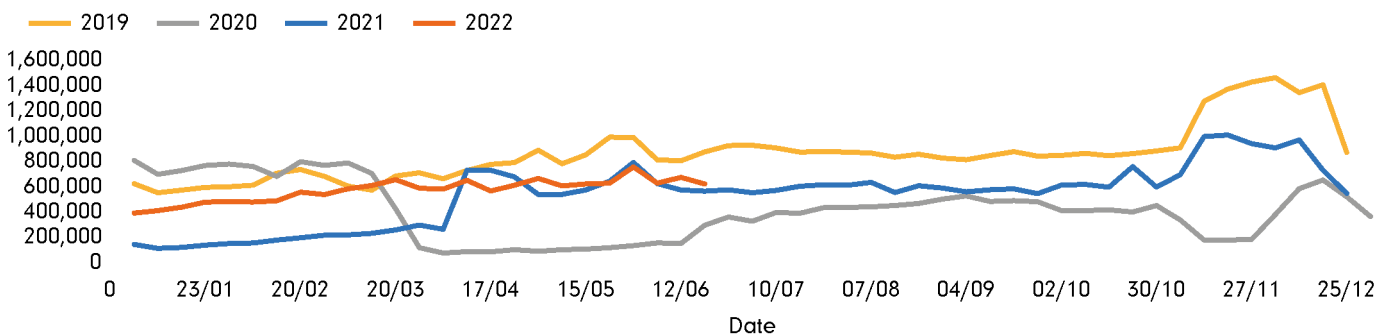
Footfall by day



Footfall by hour

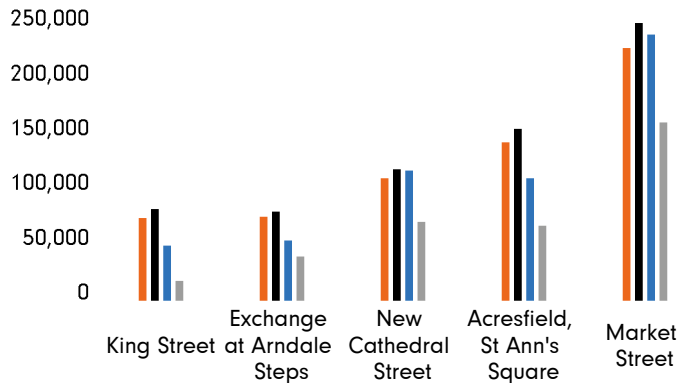

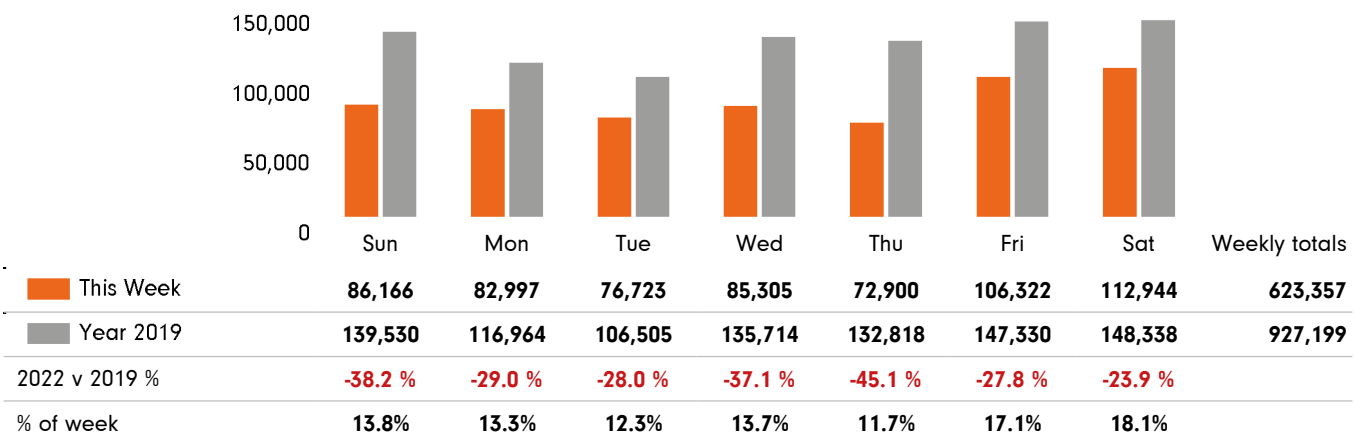
