The total number of visitors to Manchester BID for the last 52 weeks is 32,859,112 which is 45.3% up on the previous year.

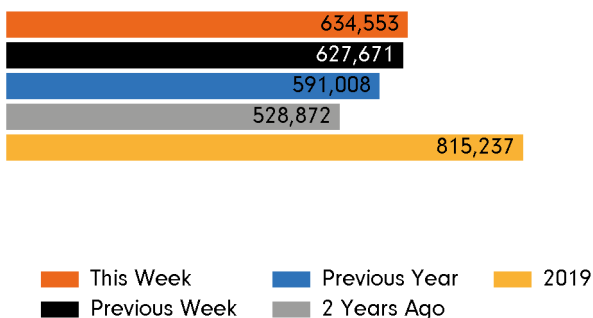
The total number of visitors for the year to date is 20,584,610 which is 31.5% up on the previous year.

The peak hour of the week was 15:00 on Saturday 3 September 2022 with footfall of 14,614.

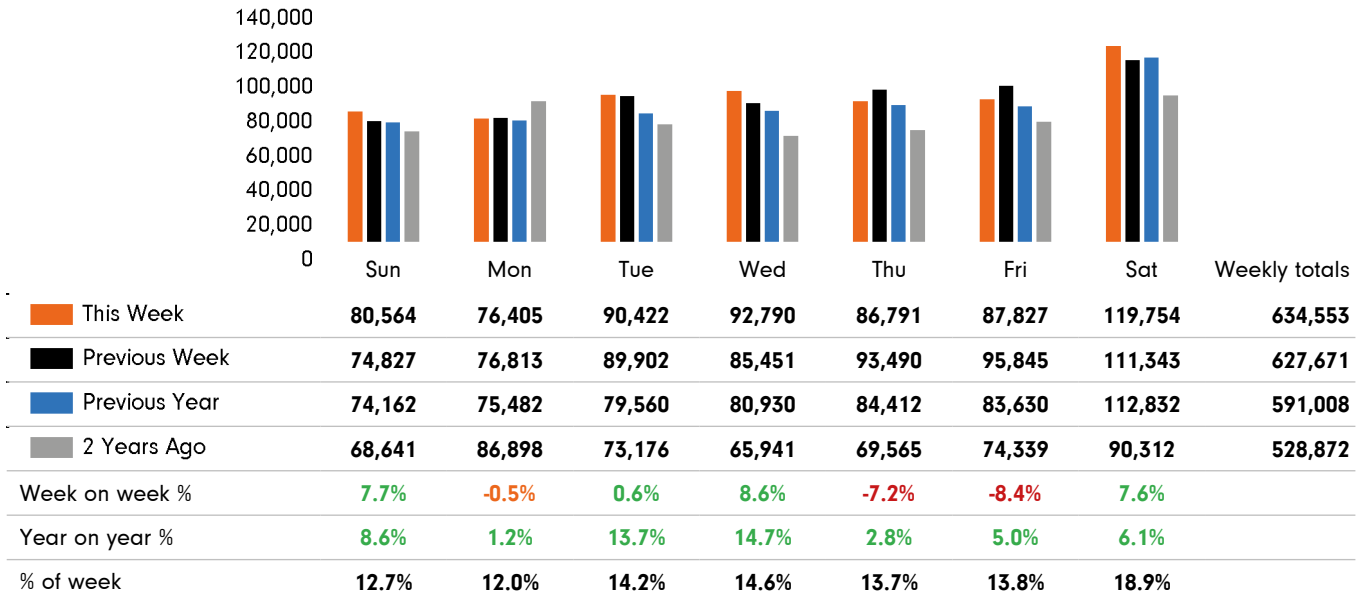

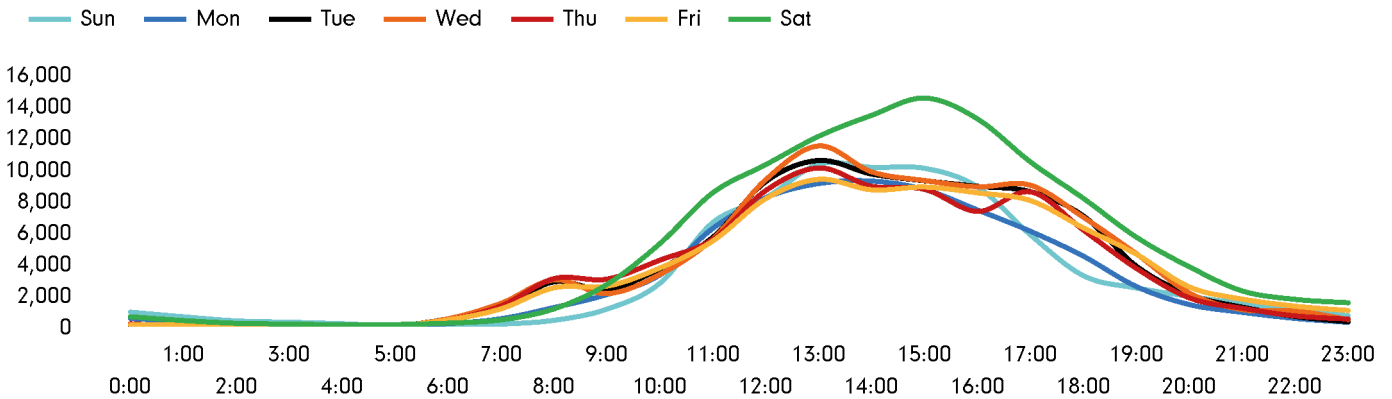

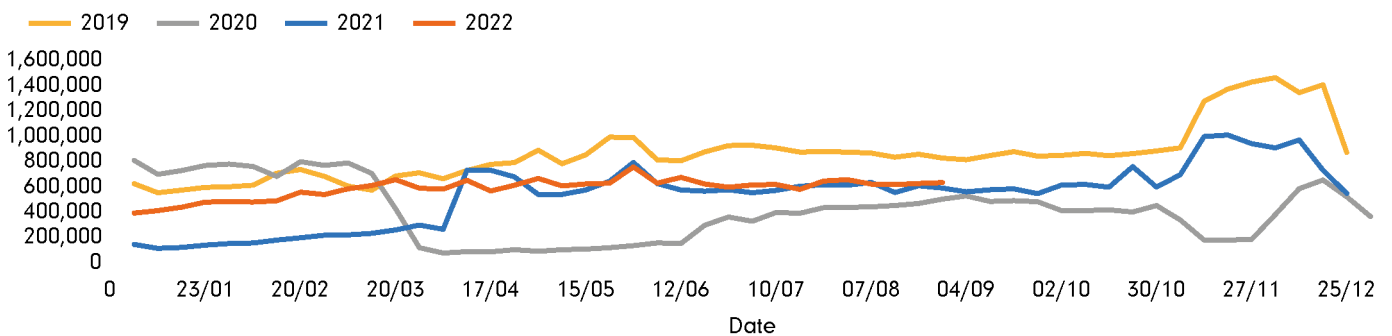
## Footfall by day



## Footfall by hour

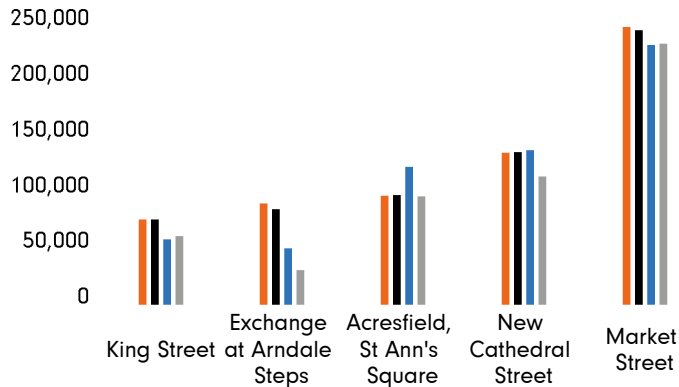

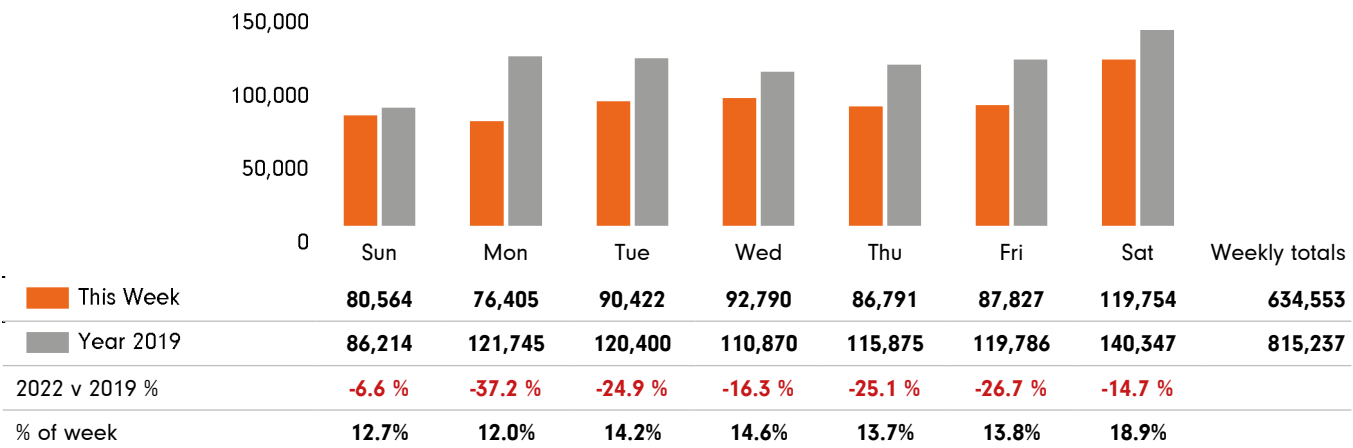
