The total number of visitors to Manchester BID for the last 52 weeks is 22,692,782 which is 28.5% down on the previous year.


The total number of visitors for the year to date is 16,217,765 which is 9.5% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors to Manchester BID in week commencing 5 September 2021 was 561,774.


The busiest day in week commencing 5 September 2021 was Saturday with 106,770 visitors.

The peak hour of the week was 15:00 on Saturday 11 September 2021 with footfall of 12,402.


#### Footfall by week










#### Footfall by hour




#### Footfall by week


