The total number of visitors to Manchester BID for the last 52 weeks is 32,967,636 which is 40.8% up on the previous year.

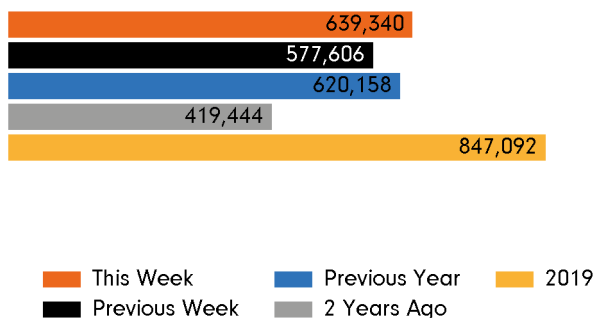
The total number of visitors for the year to date is 24,199,704 which is 26.3% up on the previous year.

The peak hour of the week was 15:00 on Saturday 15 October 2022 with footfall of 16,501.

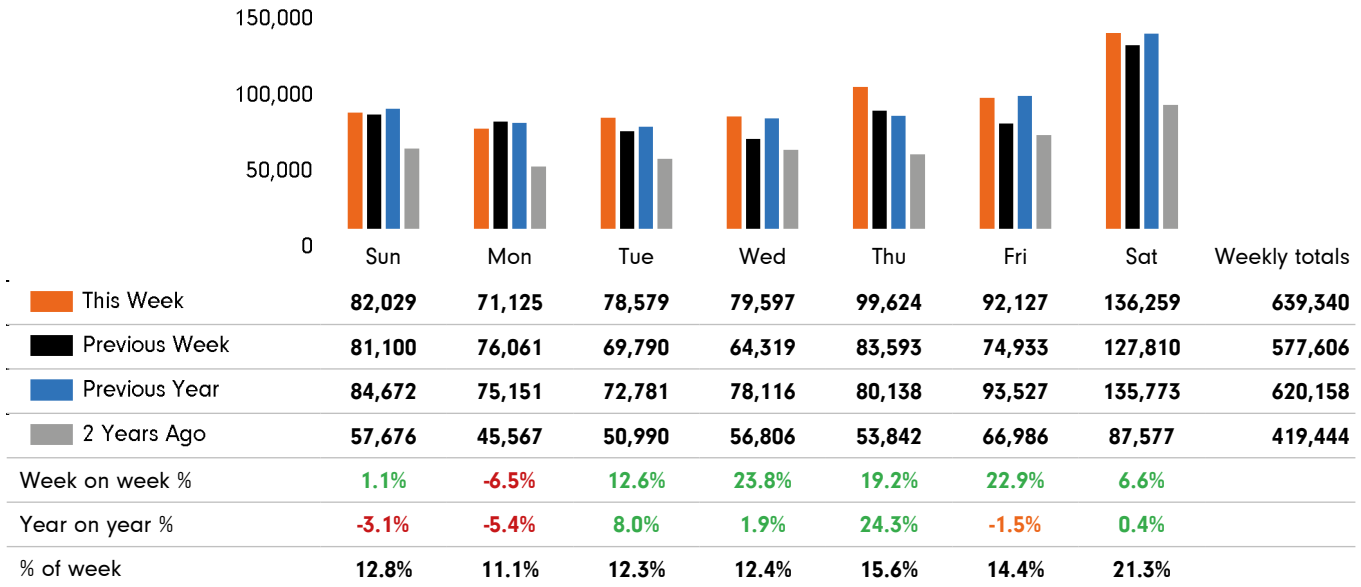
Footfall by week



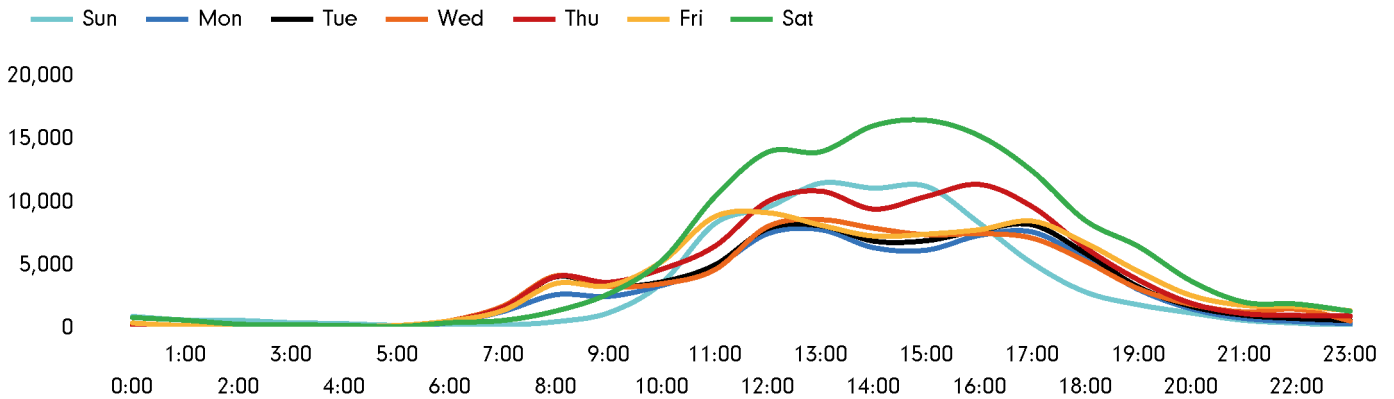

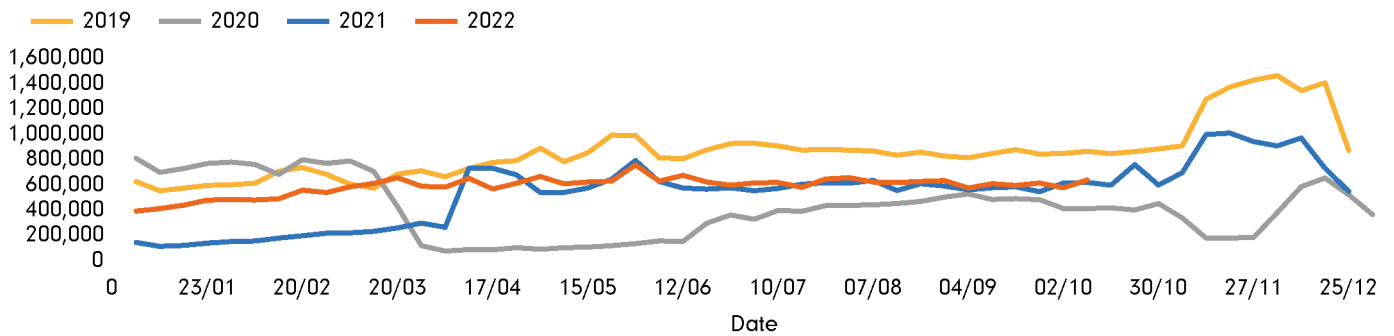
Footfall by day



Footfall by hour

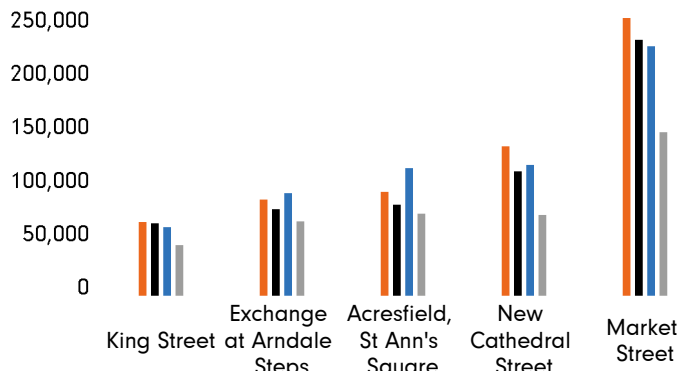


Footfall by week

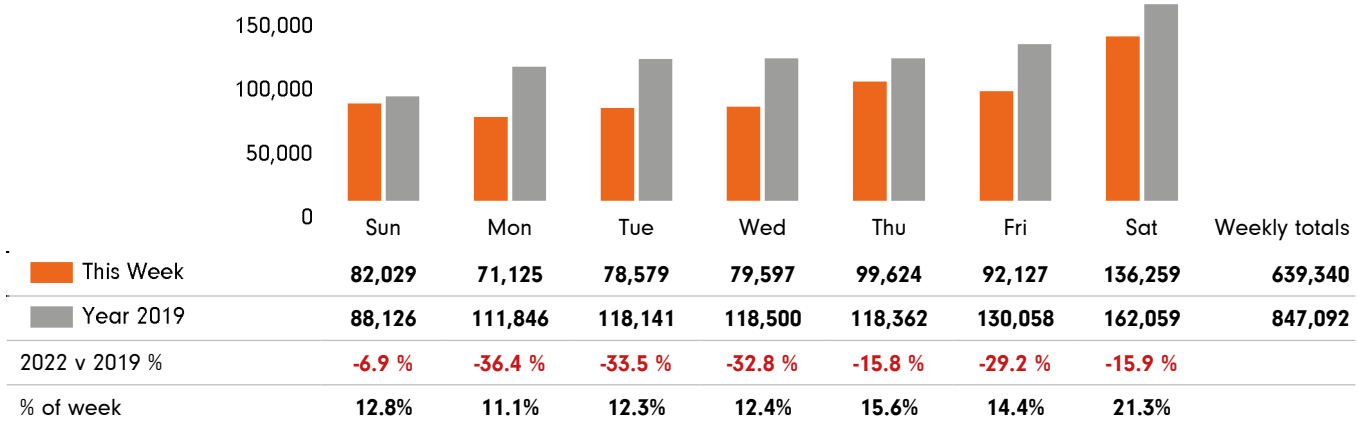
