

### **CONTEST**



"Reduce the risk to UK and its interests overseas from international terrorism so that people can go about their daily lives freely and with confidence"

**PREVENT** 

To stop people becoming terrorists or supporting terrorism.

**PURSUE** 

To stop terrorist attacks.

**PROTECT** 

To strengthen our protection against a terrorist attack.

**PREPARE** 

To mitigate the impact of a terrorist attack.

#### Threat Levels

CRITICAL

An attack is expected imminently

**SEVERE** 

An attack is highly likely

SUBSTANTIAL

An attack is a strong possibility

**MODERATE** 

An attack is possible but not likely

LOW

An attack is unlikely

### Protect

- National Counter Terrorism Security Office, (NaCTSO)
- Centre for the Protection of the National Infrastructure, (CPNI)
- Work closely with MI5
- Counter Terrorism Security Advisors

#### **CTSA Core Roles**

- 1. Protection of Crowded Places.
- 2. Protection of Hazardous Sites and Substances.
- 3. Protection of the National Infrastructure.
- 4. Personal Security.

#### **Current International Terrorism Methodology**

- Use of bladed or blunt force weapons, or using vehicles as a weapon
- Targeting of crowded places with no warning
- A number of attacks and disruptions in mainland Europe have featured firearms
- Hostile Reconnaissance conducted prior to attack







#### **Emerging Threats**

- Lone Actors & spontaneous volatile extremists
- Complex attack plots featuring organised networks e.g. Paris, Brussels
- Diverse attack threat ranging from knives, to firearms, to explosives
- Ongoing concerns over targeting of police, military and the Jewish community
- Recent attacks show intent to maximise casualties in crowded places including the night-time economy
