



- NOTES
1. All traffic signs shall comply with Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual
 2. Maximum distance between any two temporary traffic signs to be 250m.
 3. Temporary traffic signs shall not occur within 150m of an existing level crossing. The Engineer shall consult with the authority responsible for any of these types of facility prior to traffic management being installed in adjacent areas, as generally indicated.

NOTES

1. All traffic signs shall comply with Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual
2. All traffic management equipment shall be provided by the Contractor unless otherwise specified
3. All signs shall be positioned so as not to be obscured by any other object and shall not obstruct any other sign, pavement or temporary works as is reasonably practicable
4. All traffic signs shall meet the reflectance requirements of BS 673 - Part 6 - 1983, Table 1.
5. Works Access Signs to be positioned to suit ongoing works.
