The change in footfall for Manchester BID over the last 52 weeks is 2.2% up on the previous year.


Footfall for the year to date is 2.3% down on the previous year.

The busiest day in week commencing 7 April 2019 was Saturday with 114,776 visitors.


The peak hour of the week was 13:00 on Saturday 13 April 2019 with footfall of 13,518




Footfall by day




Footfall by hour




Footfall by week
