
The total number of visitors to Manchester BID for the last 52 weeks is 32,450,869 which is 97.5% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors for the year to date is 7,962,344 which is 131.3% up on the previous year.


The total number of visitors to Manchester BID in week commencing 10 April 2022 was 652,546.

The busiest day in week commencing 10 April 2022 was Saturday with 109,768 visitors.


The peak hour of the week was 15:00 on Saturday 16 April 2022 with footfall of 13,584.








Footfall by hour




Footfall by week


