
The total number of visitors to Manchester BID for the last 52 weeks is 32,734,913 which is 46.4% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors for the year to date is 18,703,455 which is 34.6% up on the previous year.


The total number of visitors to Manchester BID in week commencing 7 August 2022 was 623,030.

The busiest day in week commencing 7 August 2022 was Saturday with 102,376 visitors.


The peak hour of the week was 13:00 on Wednesday 10 August 2022 with footfall of 10,765.






# Footfall by hour




# Footfall by week


