The total number of visitors to Manchester BID for the last 52 weeks is 22,448,710 which is 31.4% down on the previous year.


The total number of visitors for the year to date is 14,455,068 which is 8.7% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors to Manchester BID in week commencing 15 August 2021 was 556,033.


The busiest day in week commencing 15 August 2021 was Saturday with 94,012 visitors.

The peak hour of the week was 14:00 on Saturday 21 August 2021 with footfall of 11,931.


#### Footfall by week










#### Footfall by hour




#### Footfall by week


