The number of visitors counted for week commencing 23 August 2020 was 504,243.


The busiest day in week commencing 23 August 2020 was Saturday with 91,034 visitors.

The peak hour of the week was 14:00 on Saturday 29 August 2020 with footfall of 12,220










Footfall by hour




Footfall by week
