The change in footfall for Manchester BID over the last 52 weeks is 36.9% down on the previous year.


Footfall for the year to date is 51.6% down on the previous year.


The number of visitors counted for week commencing 13 September 2020 was 491,627.

The busiest day in week commencing 13 September 2020 was Saturday with 100,493 visitors.


The peak hour of the week was 15:00 on Saturday 19 September 2020 with footfall of 14,113











# Footfall by hour




# Footfall by week
